Hylton Motorsports supports Air Force Memorial Fund Raising Campaign

Arlington, VA, April 8, 2004—The Air Force Memorial Foundation announced today that James Hylton Motorsports and the Ideal Racing Team has agreed to display the Air Force Memorial Foundation logo on their number 48 truck during the Martinsville, VA Kroger 250 NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series race on April 17, 2004. In part, this kind gesture by Hylton Motorsports will also serve as a tribute to the crew of the 48 truck, some of which are retired Air Force personnel.

The Air Force Memorial will honor the millions of patriotic men and women who distinguished themselves in the United States Air Force and its heritage organizations, like the Army Air Corps. The Memorial will be constructed on a promontory overlooking the Pentagon and most of Washington DC. The prominent feature of the Memorial is three stainless steel spires which will soar into the sky some 270 feet. The Air Force is the only branch of the armed forces without a memorial in the Nation's capital.

Retired Air Force Maj Gen Edward F. Grillo, Jr., the Foundation president, expressed his personal appreciation to Hylton Motorsports for their offer to do this in recognition of all the men and women of the United States Air Force and its predecessor organizations.
